

Heritage Knolls

Satellite Dishes Policy *Effective April 17, 1996*

1. The applicant should provide the Architectural review Committee with two scaled drawings showing the location for the satellite dish and the detail for the dish.
2. The dish should not be more than twenty-four (24) inches in diameter and should be located in an area away from the front of the home.
3. All electrical wiring and cable should be professionally installed according to the Village's building Ordinance and rules and a building permit should be obtained from the Village of Frankfort.
4. The homeowner is responsible for complying with any Federal, State or local law or ordinance, which regulate the use of such devices.
5. It is requested that a minimum of two weeks be given to the Architectural review Committee to review and comment for the request being made.
6. Once the construction of the structure has begun, the same must be completed within thirty (30) days.
7. There is a continuing responsibility associated with the construction of any structure. The Architectural Review Committee has the responsibility to ensure the structure is maintained, over time, in the fashion as it was originally approved.
